

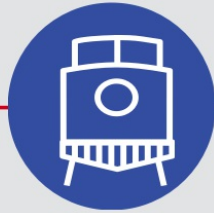

Access to the US Market

Georgia's transportation network of superior roads, rail, air and seaport make it a prime location for reaching the US market and suppliers. Barnesville/Lamar County, Georgia is located an hour's drive, south of Atlanta via Interstate 75.

Atlanta's Hartsfield-Jackson International airport is your gateway to the world by air and the port of Savannah, your gateway by the sea.

The Port of Savannah, home to the largest single-terminal container facility of its kind in North America, is comprised of two modern, deepwater terminals: Garden City Terminal and Ocean Terminal. Together, these facilities exemplify the GPA's exacting standards of efficiency and productivity. Garden City Terminal is the fourth busiest container handling facilities in the United States, encompassing more than 1,200 acres and moving millions of tons of containerized cargo annually.

Barnesville is served by Norfolk Southern Railroad. Norfolk Southern Corporation is one of the nation's premier transportation companies. Its Norfolk Southern Railway subsidiary operates approximately 19,500 route miles in 22 states and the District of Columbia, serves every major container port in the eastern United States, and provides efficient connections to other rail carriers. Norfolk Southern operates the most extensive intermodal network in the East and is a major transporter of coal, automotive, and industrial products.

For corporate travel, the Upson County (OPN) airport is 8 miles from Barnesville's industrial sites. OPN currently provides 6,350 feet of runway, an ILS approach and AWOS. There are 97 based aircraft, including eight business operations, 100 T-hangars and four corporate hangars, two of which are brand new.
